

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR
COOPERATION**

BETWEEN

**THE UNIVERSITY OF DAR ES SALAAM, DAR ES
SALAAM, TANZANIA**

AND

**THE FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES, KASETSART
UNIVERSITY, BANGKOK, THAILAND**

The Faculty of Social Sciences, Kasetsart University, Bangkok, Thailand, and the University of Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, are both charged with fostering and supporting academic endeavours in the social sciences and humanities, including those pertaining to Asia and Africa.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall cover academic activities which fall within the reach of each organisation's subject remit.

The two organisations together will hereafter be referred to as *The Parties*.

Article I

The Parties will, on a basis of equality and mutual benefit, support academic cooperation across a wide spectrum of the social sciences, including interdisciplinary related fields, between highly qualified scholars affiliated to both Parties.

Article II

Under this Memorandum of Understanding, cooperation may include the following activities:

- Joint workshops and other events
- Exchange of researchers and students
- Joint research projects
- Joint fundraising proposals
- Participation in academic networks
- Other cooperative activities as may be mutually agreed upon

Article III

Administrative procedures for implementing this Memorandum of Understanding are set forth separately, and may be amended by mutual written agreement between The Parties. Activities under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be subject to the applicable laws and regulations of each country.

Article IV

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be executed by the following parties for its successful implementation on behalf of their institutions:

Article V

Intellectual property rights belong to the researcher and his/her employing institution. Due acknowledgement of support received from both Parties should be made in the publication of any research resulting from this programme.

Article VI

Amendments or modifications to this Memorandum of Understanding may be suggested at any time. They will come into effect upon mutual written agreement between The Parties. When amendments result in a significant change in the practice or implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding, a period of notice of no less than six months will be given.

Article VII

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force on the date of its signing, and shall remain in force thereafter for five years. Termination of or significant amendment to this Memorandum of Understanding shall not interfere with any ongoing, not-fully-concluded activities at the time of such termination or amendment.

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and signed in Bangkok and Dar es Salaam.
